#### Terms of Use (Bulletin subscription and license)

Subscription to the *American Ceramic Society Bulletin* provides the subscriber access to all issues of the magazine from the past 100+ years in a digital format.

Subscription period: The subscription period will be activated upon purchase and will extend for 12 months from that date. Users cannot access the *Bulletin* after their subscription ends or is cancelled.

Access protocols: Subscriber access will be authenticated via IP addresses through bulletin.ceramics. org. Username/password authentication is not available. Subscribers can access the *Bulletin* remotely through virtual private networks (VPNs) keyed to their institution's IP addresses.
